

Pupil Premium 2012-13

Hunton + Arrathorne CP School was allocated £4988 Pupil Premium funding in the year 2012-13.

The funding was used to:

- Improve tracking and develop challenging targets for children to provide an accurate picture of pupil progress to aid smooth transition and achievement within our school. School invested in a new Assessment scheme.
- Enable pupils to access enrichment activities
- Provide supply cover to enable G+T pupils to attend extension activities
- Provision of TA one-to-one support in English to help develop language skills

Impact

- All children are set challenging end of KS targets and half termly assessments measure progress and inform planning and individual targets to improve reading, writing and mathematics.
- Children were able to take part in a residential visit to London.
- G+T pupils attended Maths Challenge sessions at cluster schools
- Children make progress towards individual targets on their support programmes.
- Service pupils KS2 made better than expected progress in reading, writing and maths.
- Service pupils in KS1 attained above national expectations in reading and maths and in line and above in writing.
- Service pupils in FS made expected progress in Literacy and Maths.
- FSM pupils made good progress or better in maths and expected or better progress in reading and writing.
