

Pupil Premium 2013-14

Hunton + Arrathorne CP School was allocated £4500 Pupil Premium funding in the year 2013-14.

The funding is being used:

- To enable pupils to access enrichment activities such as a residential visit to BewerleyPark
- For staff training for Reading Intervention to help pupils who have attended a number of schools to fill the gaps
- TA provision to deliver Reading Intervention programme
- Provision of TA one-to-one support for English
- Time for teachers to spend on individual meetings with pupils part of our Assertive Mentoring programme
- HM Heroes subscription
- Additional TA hours to organise and manage Service Pupil attendance at HMS Heroes branch meetings
- Additional TA hours to support vulnerable pupils during lessons to help them achieve targets in literacy and maths.
