

## Pupil Premium 2015-16

Hunton + Arrathorne CP School was allocated £9260 Pupil Premium funding in the year 2015-16.

The funding is being used for:

- Additional TA hours for vulnerable pupils;
- Purchasing assessment packages to enable accurate and up-to-date assessment of pupils to ensure appropriate target setting and tracking takes place;
- Funding for TA in KS2. Supporting vulnerable pupils' learning in the classroom by helping them achieve or exceed their attainment targets in literacy and maths.
- To contribute to HMS Heroes initiative
- TA support to help close the gap with programmes like Better Reading Support Programmes, IDL programme
- To organise and manage Service pupils attendance at HMS Heroes branch meetings
- TA support for FS/KS1 pupils to make progress towards age –related expectations 5x1/2 days
