Around the Classes...

Class 1: In Class One we have begun our Whatever the Weather theme in earnest. We began by making up stormy stories and acted them out using crafts, small world and play dough. In Geography, we have thought about weather changes across the seasons and made rain gauges. We are experimenting on how seeds grow in different things including soil, sand and hand sanitizer!

Class 2: Class 2 have been busy this week rehearsing the words and songs for our up coming production. Year 3 and 4 have been using this as a speaking and listening opportunity as well as honing their drama skills. Year 2 have been focusing on writing for different purposes. In maths, year 2s have been looking at measuring and comparing lengths while years 3 and 4 have been starting their work on decimals. It's a tricky topic but they have approached it with their usual determination.

Class 3: Our English focus this week has been based around our performances of 'Wow, What a Year' – we have also continued to study the short-film 'The Piano' in our English lessons and we are using this to help build our knowledge of camera angles etc. to help with our recordings. In Maths we have brushed up on lots of skills, including developing our understanding of ratio and translations. As usual, wonderful work from all!
