Around the Classes...

Robin Class: This week in Robin Class have been continuing to develop their Goldilocks and the Gruffalo stories by adding lots of adjectives and star words. Reception have enjoyed learning their new sounds this week, especially 'm' which went well with the giant marshmallows 'mmmm.' Year 1 have been working hard in maths learning their bonds of 10 and exploring how to partition numbers. In science we have been learning about our senses, this week was all about the sense of hearing.

Kingfisher Class: A super week in Kingfisher Class! We had a fantastic day out completing our science cross-curricular learning on Wednesday. The Year 2 children followed our school rules well and were great ambassadors for our school. They have also worked very hard back in the classroom – developing their inequality skills and expanding noun phrases. I can't wait for another exciting week of learning next week!

Partridge Class: Partridge Class have been busy this week, finishing our short stories including a conversation between two characters. In maths, we worked super hard during our lesson on roman numerals and have now moved onto rounding numbers. We also enjoyed an exciting visit from the PCSO's on Thursday, who talked to us about road safety. Partridge Class are very much looking forward to our trip next week, don't forget your wellies!

Woodpecker Class: On Wednesday, the Woodpeckers (and the Kingfishers) went on our school trip to Foxglove Covert to enhance our learning of 'animals and living things' in science. The children had a thoroughly enjoyable time and learnt many interesting things; the guides were blown away with the knowledge of our children. Of course, their behaviour was exemplary throughout and we were even lucky with the weather! In school, we have been focussing on writing a formal letter to Zeus based on our class text and we have been learning more about Roman Numerals in maths too. We ended the week with a visit from our road safety officers to ensure our children know how to be safe when out in the community.
