Robin Class: Robin Class have been very busy getting our fingers stronger. We have been cutting and pinching and twisting and bending... it is making our pencil grips even better. We have also made up a story about Goldilocks visiting the Gruffalo's cave. In geography we have made 3D maps of the Gruffalo woods.

Kingfisher Class: The Year 2 children have worked their socks off this week! From getting to grips with inequalities and ordering in maths, to considering how to make notes and add adjectives to create expanded noun phrases – we have been very busy! They have also honed their geography skills with Mrs. Cromey-Hawke by investigating the human and physical features of Bedale. Well done Kingfishers!

Partridge Class: Partridge class have loved taking part in cross country this week! We are very impressed with how hard everyone tried! We have also particularly enjoyed English this week, where we have continued with our story 'Stone Age Boy'. This week we focused on speech, using an image from the book to imagine a conversation between two characters. We have then practised writing speech correctly using macaroni pasta as speech marks, which we thought was great fun!

Woodpecker Class: We've had another exciting week in the Woodpecker Class. In English we have been looking at the difference between formal and informal vocabulary, whilst in maths we have been learning more about positive and negative numbers. On Thursday, the children participated in a Cross Country event at Richmond School and we were so impressed with their resilience, competitiveness and behaviour throughout the day. They really did our school proud so a big well done to everyone!
