# Around the Classes...

**Robin Class:** This week the Robins have been learning about fact books and have begun to write their own about woodland creatures. We have also been developing our mapping skills in geography and have drawn maps of Hunton, adding a key and symbols. We all had an amazing day at Foxglove Covert being nature detectives and were wonderful ambassadors for our school being Kind, Safe and Driven in every aspect of the day!

**Kingfisher Class:** This week we have explored what happens when we count in different numbers (not always starting at zero!) We have worked with counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and even 3's – we are so good at our counting we have even started to answer some tricky problems. In English, we have started our final piece of lighthouse writing by reading, analysing and following instructions. We are going to use our skills to make some tasty 'lighthouse sandwiches' next week. Year 2 have also been incredibly busy with Mrs. Webster in R.E creating a harvest prayer to share at our Harvest Festival next Friday. Well done, superstars!

Partridge Class: After hearing fantastic reviews from Woodpeckers and Kingfishers, we were really looking forward to our trip to Foxglove Covert this week- and the trip did not disappoint! We had an amazing time mini beast hunting and pond dipping. We even caught many fish, which was very exciting- see Seesaw for pictures! We have finished our topic 'diary entries' in our writing this week and have moved onto our new topic 'addition and subtraction' in maths. Woodpecker Class: This week in Woodpecker Class we have been working on addition and subtraction problems in maths and we have been researching the stone age in more detail to help with our non-chronological report. The children have continued to work hard and impressed me with their brilliant work. In PSHCE they have challenged stereotypes and in Science we pushed ourselves physically to investigate the effects of exercise on our heart rates!.
