#### Around the Classes...

Robin Class (Reception): Wow what a week!! This week has been hugely focused on our production 'Angel Express'! The children have worked so hard and put on not one, but two fantastic shows! We've also enjoyed exploring 'The Gingerbread Man' animation and story in drawing club, making ginger scented playdoh, creating bridges for the gingerbread man to cross the river - to name a few! On Thursday we visited the pantomime in Darlington- which was fantastic! We ended our week with Christmas Jumper Day and our school Christmas dinner! We hope the children have a well-deserved rest over the weekend- well done Reception Robin class! Robin Class (Year 1): The children were absolute superstars in their performances of 'Angel Express'. It was a pleasure to watch the children perform, showing how determined and driven they are. We are extremely delighted with them all and they have shared the festive spirit! We enjoyed lots of Christmas stories this week, a favourite has been 'Lucy and Tom at Christmas'. Subtraction has been introduced in maths, really trying hard to grasp this concept and explore subtraction using concrete resources to help us. We even turned into frogs to make our own subtraction sentence! We have been working extremely hard on phonic assessments this week, wonderful to see the progression and hear the children read with exquisite prosody. And, finally we loved the visit to the pantomime, showing off with our outstanding behaviour!

**Kingfisher Class:** I am sure everyone will agree that the Kingfishers have had a brilliant week, particularly their performance of 'Angel Express'. They were loud and clear and performed each of their roles wonderfully well so a big well done to all involved. This was followed up with a trip to the pantomime on Thursday which the children really enjoyed. As always, their behaviour was impeccable, and they were amazing ambassadors for the school. In class, we have continued our work in addition and subtraction, focussing more on written methods using column. The children have picked this up really well and it is something we will continue to develop in the new year. A big well done to everyone for this week as we look forward to more exciting things to come in our final week of term. **Partridge Class:** This week in Partridge Class has been full of festive joy. We thoroughly enjoyed watching the Robins and Kingfishers' nativity. The children were amazing! Our Thursday afternoon at the pantomime at Darlington Hippodrome was filled with laughs and giggles. Also, we have been working extremely hard in perfecting our Christingle, and we can't wait to share our efforts with you next week. In our English sessions, we explored the world of animals through amazing Kenning poems. Can you guess which animals some of the children chose to write about? Here are some clues...carrot-muncher, sleigh-puller, snowflake-chaser... In science, we delved into the world of food chains, grasping key vocabulary like producer, prey, consumer and predator.

**Woodpecker Class:** Woodpeckers have time travelled back to the 1940's and written diary entries imagining they are a child during WW2. It has been a fantastic opportunity for them to showcase their knowledge about WW2, a topic they have thoroughly enjoyed. We have also got into the Christmas spirit watching the KS1 Nativity and visiting Darlington Hippodrome to watch Snow White and the Seven Dwarves. We have had a fantastic week!
