Around the Classes...

Robin Class (Reception): We thoroughly enjoyed holding our Drawing Club open morning to share a sneak peek into our Drawing Club adventures. Each week, we have a themed text, vocabulary and a progression of drawing across the week including characters, a setting and adventure days using our special codes to change the picture! It was lovely to see the children enjoying showing this to you and the energy and excitement in the room was joyous! The Pantomime was a highlight of the week where the children were a credit to our school, following our golden rules whilst having fun!

Robin Class (Year 1): The fun festivities have really stepped up this week. The pantomime was a fabulous treat and the children cared, aspired and excelled with their behaviours. A real pleasure taking them on a special trip. We consolidated our history topic 'Who is the Greatest Explorer?' in time for the H&A Museum visit. The children have worked really hard in their Autumn 2 phonic assessments and we ended the week with a delicious Christmas lunch.

Kingfisher Class: We have had a brilliant week in Kingfisher Class with a real mix of 'hard work' and 'Christmas fun'. In Maths, we have moved onto our multiplication unit, counting in various multiples, whilst in History we completed our Ancient Egypt study by considering whether Ancient Egyptian artefacts should be kept in British museums or returned to their native country. It was lovely to welcome so many of you to our H&A Museum and the children loved showing off some of their learning as well as competing in the 'Pyramid Challenge'! Wednesday saw our annual visit to Darlington Hippodrome for 'Sleeping Beauty'; the children had a wonderful time and were, as always, such great ambassadors for our school.

Partridge Class: Partridge Class have had a brilliant, festive week, as we get closer to the end of this term. We had a lovely time delivering Christmas cards around the village, the children loved giving to others and spreading Christmas cheer! They have also thoroughly enjoyed their annual trip to the pantomime on Wednesday to watch Sleeping Beauty. They continued their fabulous work in Maths exploring angles and continued learning more about The Tempest in English.
