Around the Classes...

Robin Class (Reception): We have started our new topic 'Zoom to the Moon' and enjoyed our book of the week - 'Aliens Love Underpants'. We predicted what it would be by investigating clues taking on roles of a detective!

We have enjoyed enthusiastically re-enacting the story taking on different roles of different characters. We have had a mysterious object landing in our classroom....and wonder if an alien may be visiting Hunton and Arrathorne School! Alongside the whole school DT days, we have been designing and making our own large scale vehicles for 'No Outsiders' parade! The children have worked amazingly in teams (see Tapestry for the end results!) What an exciting first week back! **Robin Class (Year 1):** It has been great to welcome back the Robin Class after the Christmas break and we have had a very exciting first week back. We started off with a 'No Outsiders Day', our book was 'That's NOT How You Do It!' The children fully engaged with this and enjoyed sharing what they were good at, and similarities and differences with their friends. PE has seen us begin gymnastics this term, focusing on balance. We had our termly Design Technology days where the children were using their skills to produce box vehicles with moving wheels, with a 'No Outsiders' unique design. A great week back and I am sure these positive attitudes will continue throughout the term!

Kingfisher Class: It has been lovely to welcome each of the children back this week; they have very clearly had an incredibly exciting time over the Christmas break. The main focus of this week has been our DT project, using wheels and axles to make a No Outsiders themed vehicle. The children produced some great designs and thoroughly enjoyed using tools such as saws and glue guns (under very close supervision!) to help create their models. We have had a brilliant first week back and I am sure this will continue throughout the term!

Partridge Class: What an exciting first week back at school! We kick started the week with 'No Outsiders' by reading the book 'Dogs Don't do Ballet.' Then on Wednesday we began our exciting Design Technology topic where we designed and made our very own No Outsiders torches. The children were really inquisitive as they explored electrical circuits and used their problem-solving skills to make a homemade switch out of split pins and a paperclip. The children made thoughtful and well-considered design choices to create a final product. They all looked amazing- we were all creators this week! We also had our first tennis session where we began to develop our racket and ball control skills.

Woodpecker Class: We have had a lovely first week back in Woodpeckers to kickstart 2024. The children enjoyed exploring our No Outsiders text 'The Island' and created fantastic comic strips inspired by the story. We are also enjoying our class read 'Who let the Gods Out?' in story time. I am so proud of the children's hard work and efforts in Design Technology. They have created fantastic masks, with an electrical component, expressing their creativity and individuality.
