Around the Classes...

Robin Class (Reception): Wow what a busy week! We have been designing our own dragons with the most amazing imaginative creations and writing descriptions about them! On Tuesday, the children showed how 'Happy and Healthy' they all are at our Sports Day! We were so proud of each and every one of them for persevering and trying really hard! We have also very busy rehearsing for a special event on Monday morning! We hope to see as many of you as possible at our Reception class assembly (we will record it for Tapestry for those who can't make it).

Robin Class (Year 1): We were both 'happy & healthy' and 'risk takers' during our sporting events this week; sports morning where we all excelled showing off our skills, then so much fun was had at the local 'Fun Run!' We loved aspiring like athletes in all activities. In Maths, we have consolidated our understanding of halves and quarters and we have risen to the challenge and answered like mathematicians. In History, we explored parts of a castle and we learnt about Duke Conan. In Science, we have considered how humans and animals are affected by the seasons whilst in music we have been busy learning a song all about the beach.

Kingfisher Class: We were so proud of the children on Tuesday morning: their attitudes and determination during our 'Sports Morning' were great and they competed with big smiles throughout.
