The following vocabulary is introduced in Reception	
the physical part of a computer	
a network of computers all over the world	
the part of a computer which you cannot touch	
The following vocabulary is introduced in Year 1	
things we use to communicate with	
when the internet, mobile phones or other technology is used to hurt others	
information	
computers linked over a building or area	
a word or series of characters which keep your information secure	
the operating system for the internet	
The following vocabulary is introduced in Year 2	
a set of instructions needed to complete a task	
information that goes into a computer	
information which is personal to you and should be kept secure	
a collection of instructions or algorithms which open on a computer	
The following vocabulary is introduced in Year 3 & 4	
checking the code of a computer programme and changing it if needed	
information that comes out of a computer	
when a program repeats itself	
information we want to keep but which can change	
The following vocabulary is introduced in Year 5 & 6	
the language computers use (made up of 1s and 2s)	
the process a computer undergoes when it creates algorithms	
the operating system sits between the software and hardware
