Head Boy and Head Girl (Year 6)	The Head Boy and Head Girl are responsible for setting excellent standards for the rest of the school. Pupil Leadership Team (Rec – Y6)	The Pupil Leadership Team will be elected by their peers and represent their class. Hunton Heroes (Rec – Y6)	Hunton Heroes is our service pupil group. They work with the service pupil lead to represent our military children. Reading Ambassadors (Y1 – Y6)	Reading ambassadors embody our curriculum aim of being ‘Lifelong Readers’ and promote a love of reading across school. They will meet fortnightly. They will ensure reading environments in school are well-organised and tidy and promote reading on a lunchtime.
